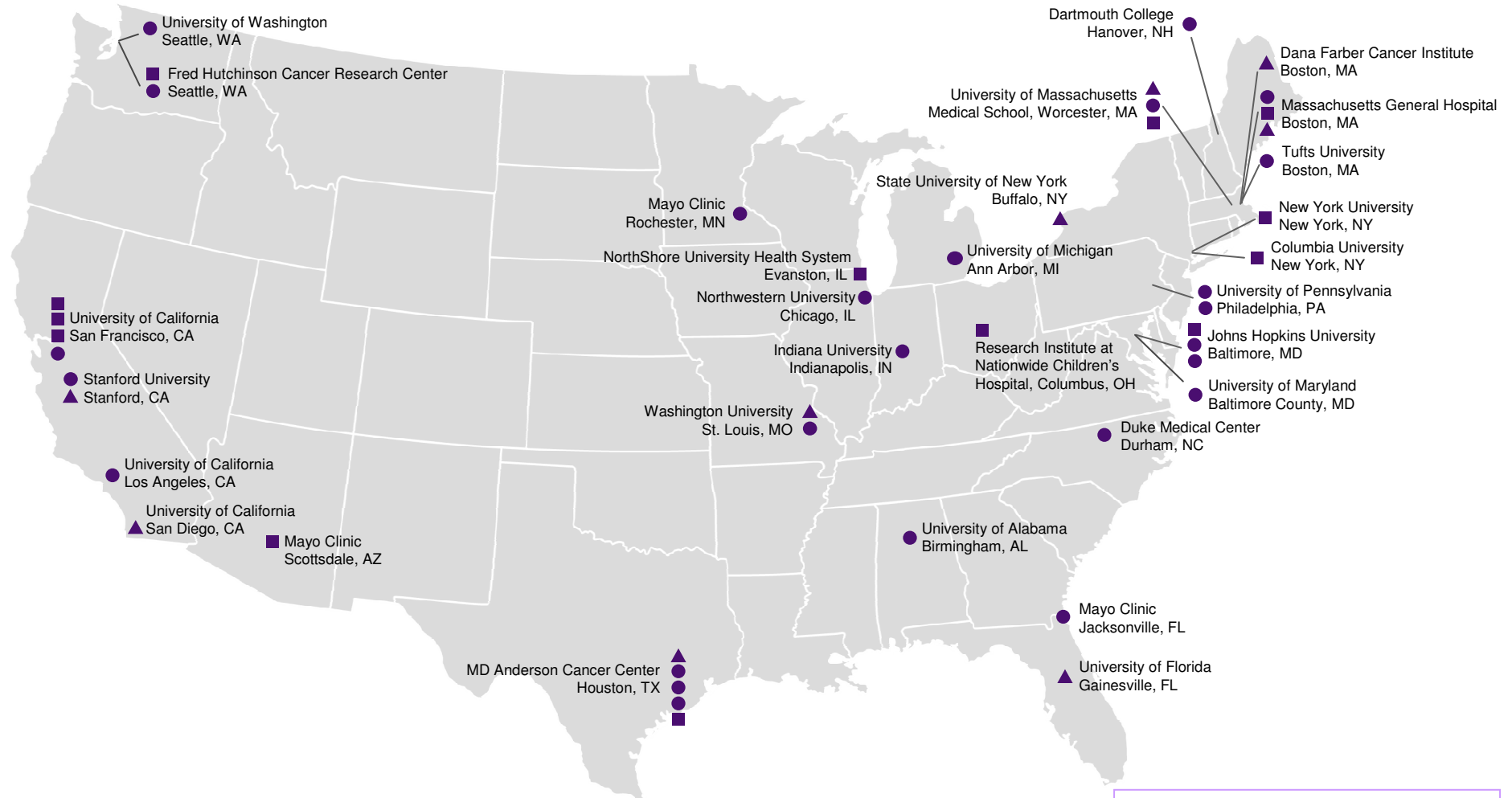


Geographic Spread: 2003 - 2009

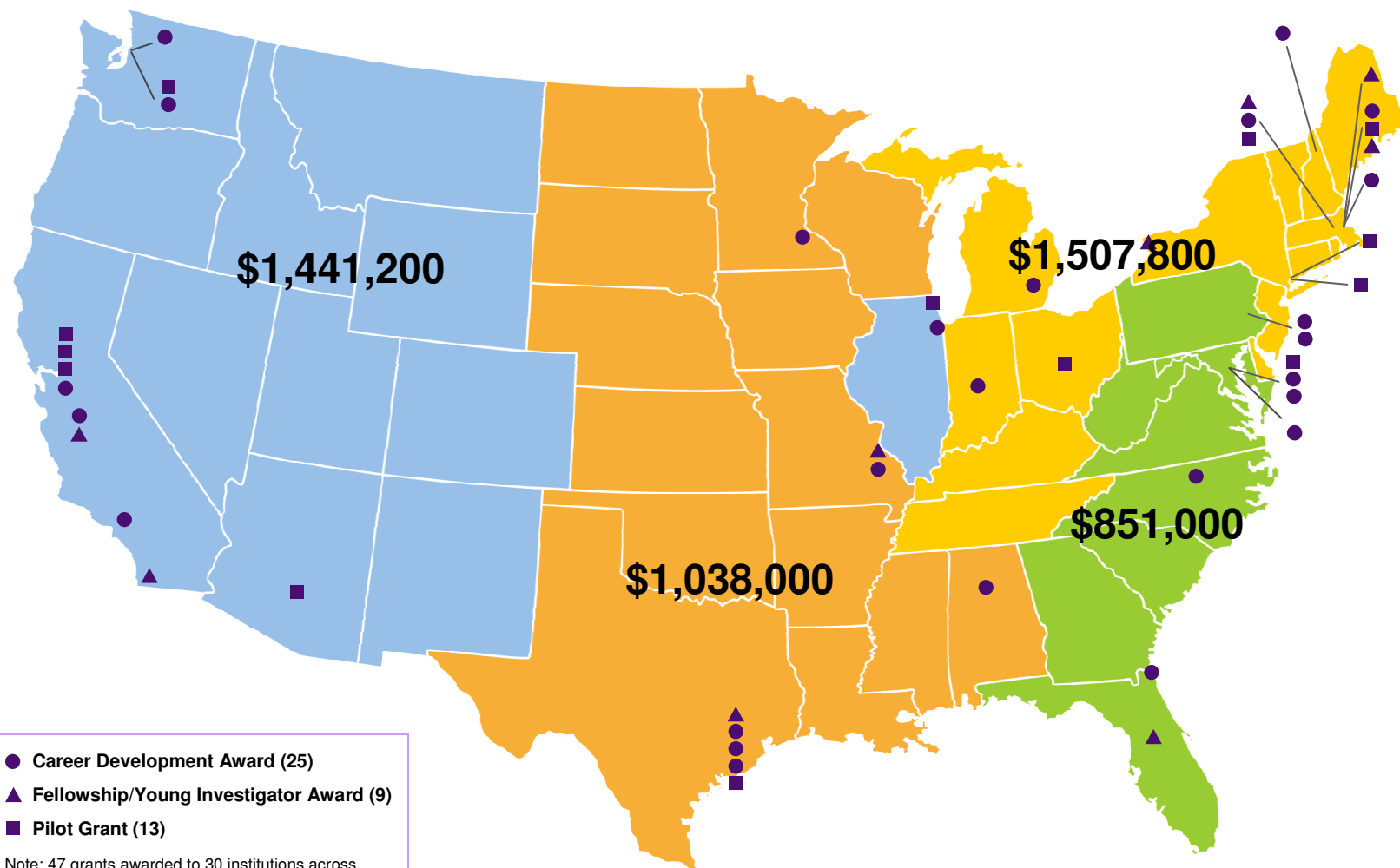

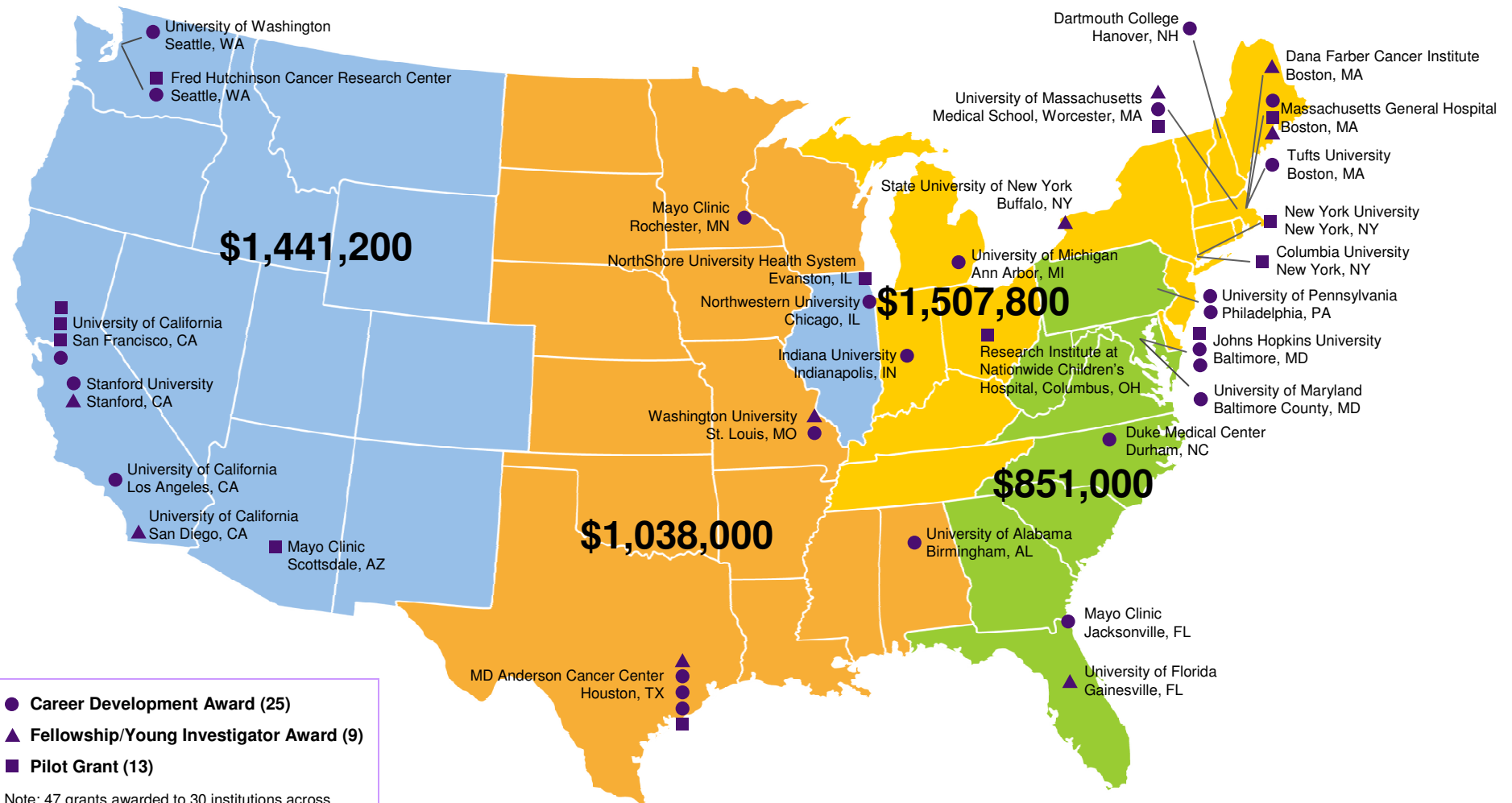

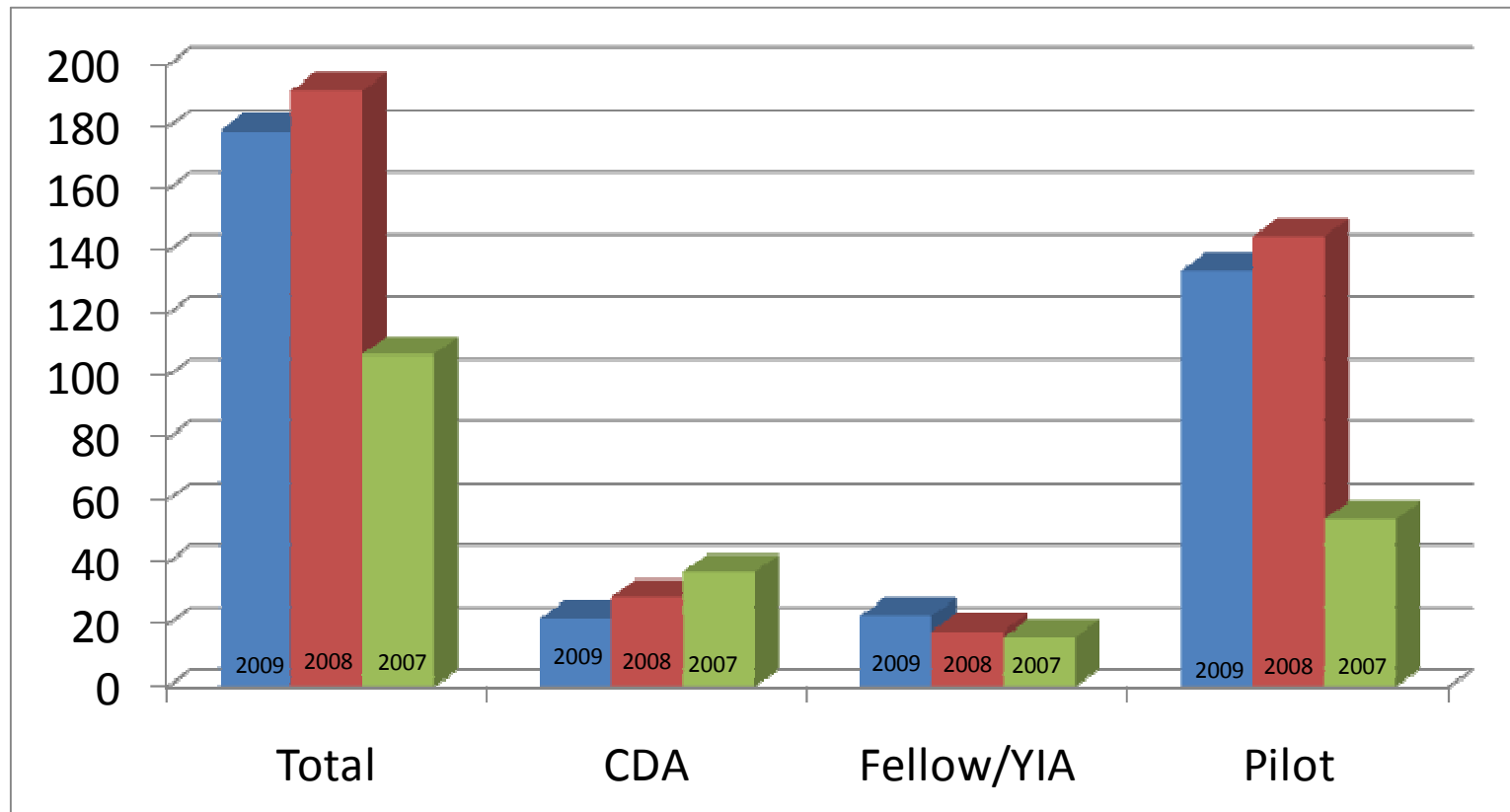

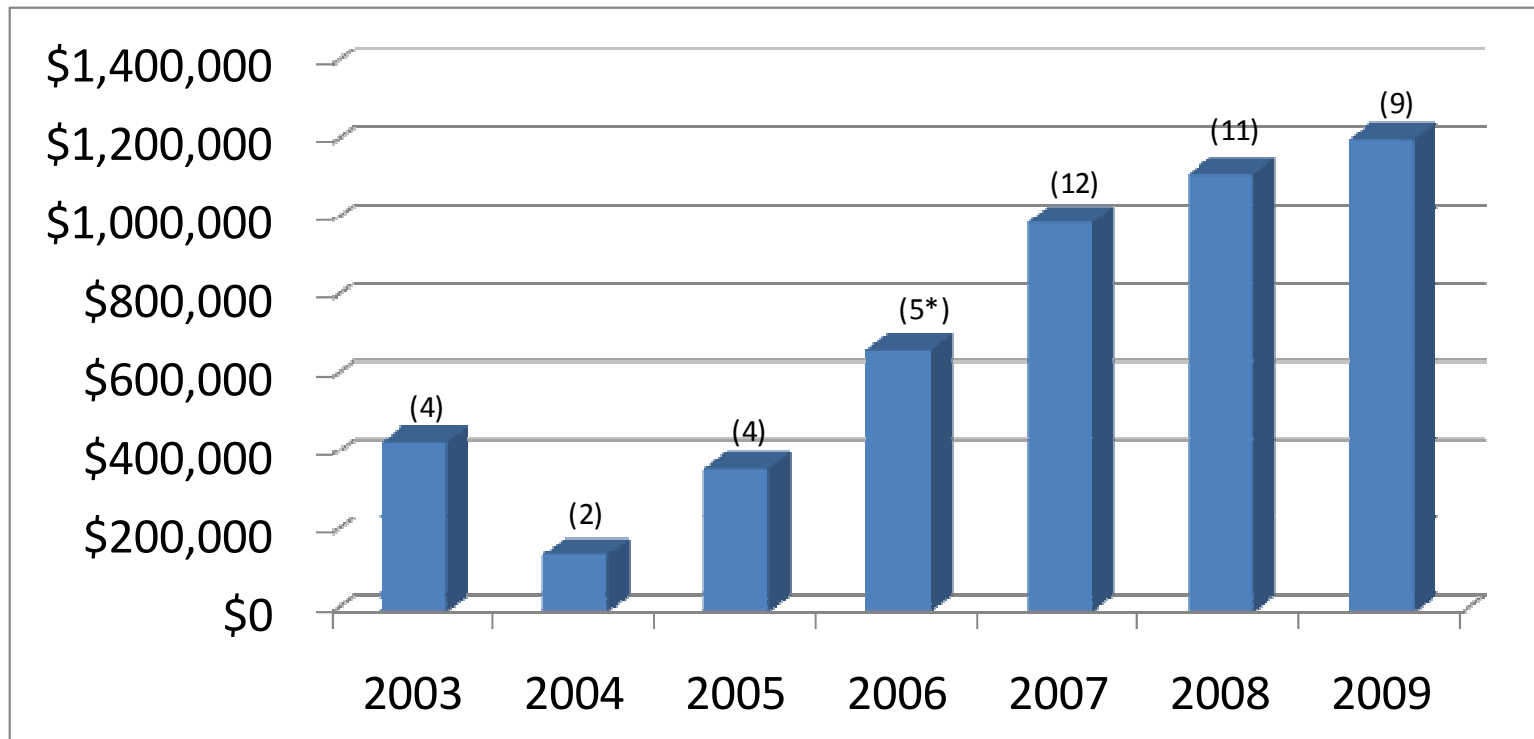
Application Submissions: 2007 - 2009

Total Annual Funding: 2003 – 2009

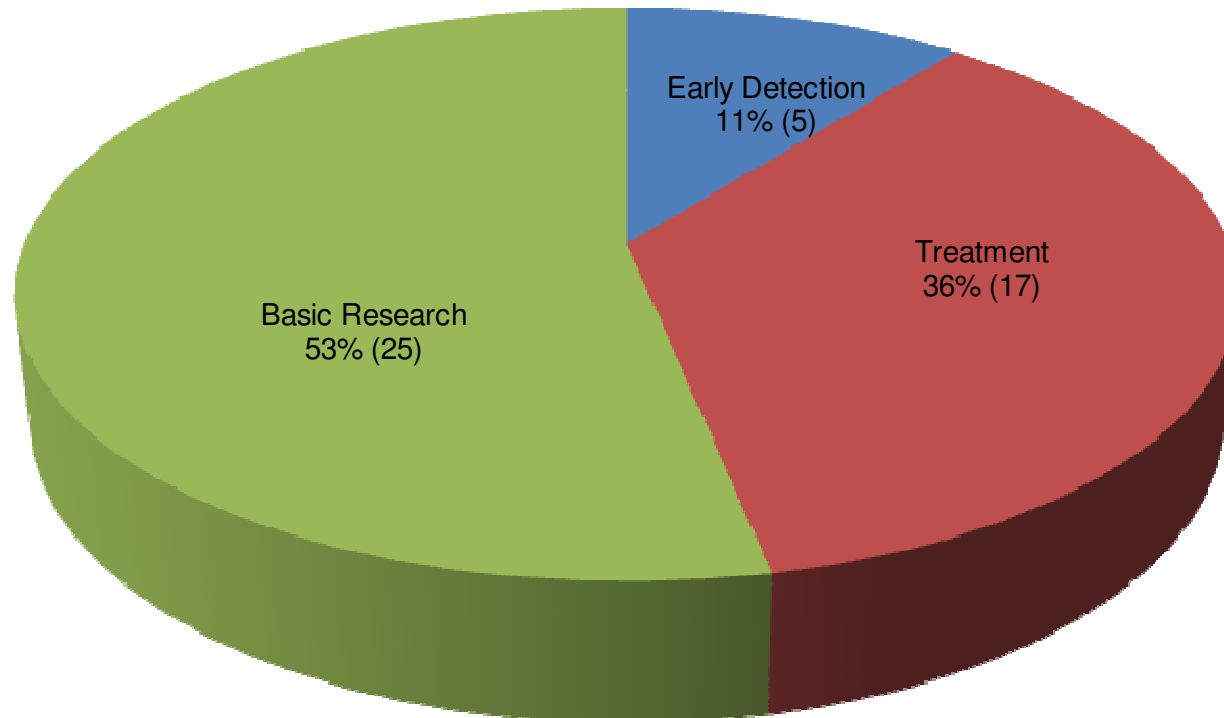

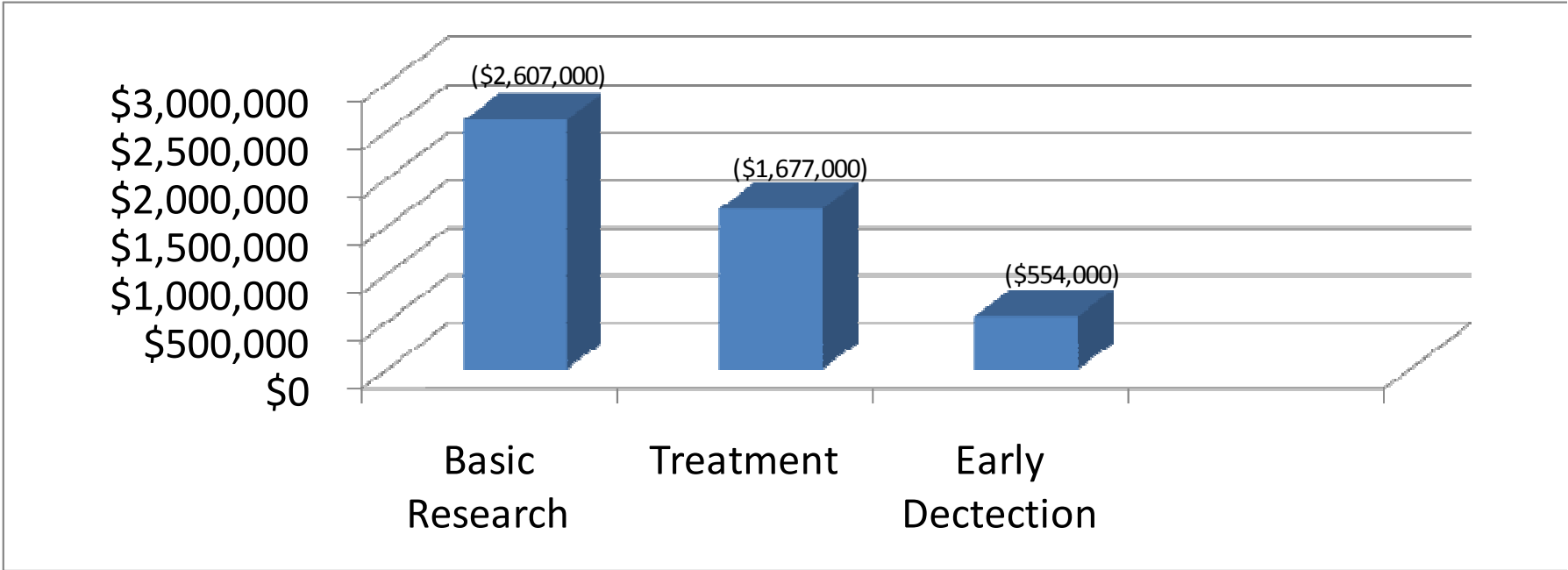
Grants by Field of Interest: 2003 – 2009

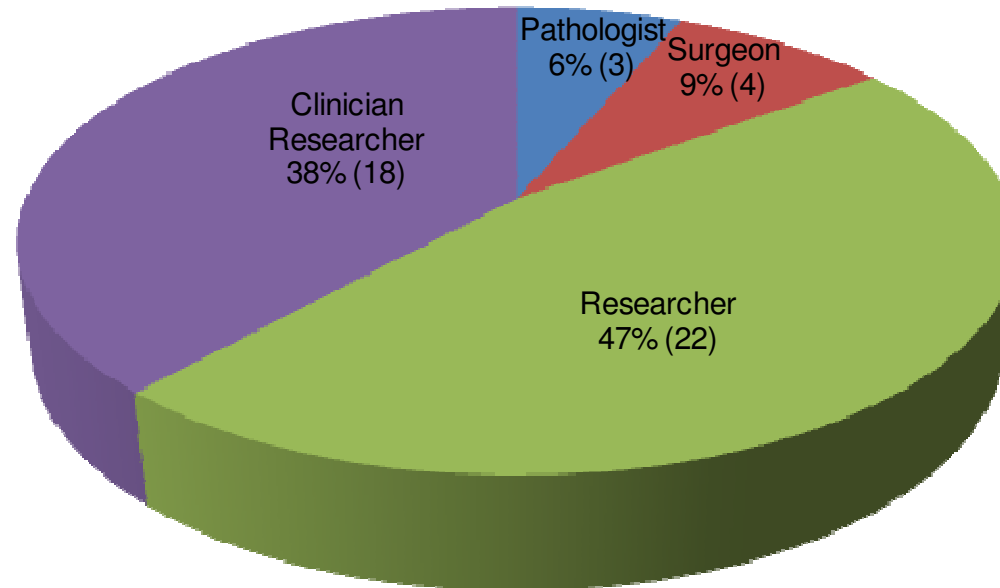


Note: "Basic Research" focuses on understanding disease initiation and progression.

Funding by Field of Interest: 2003 – 2009

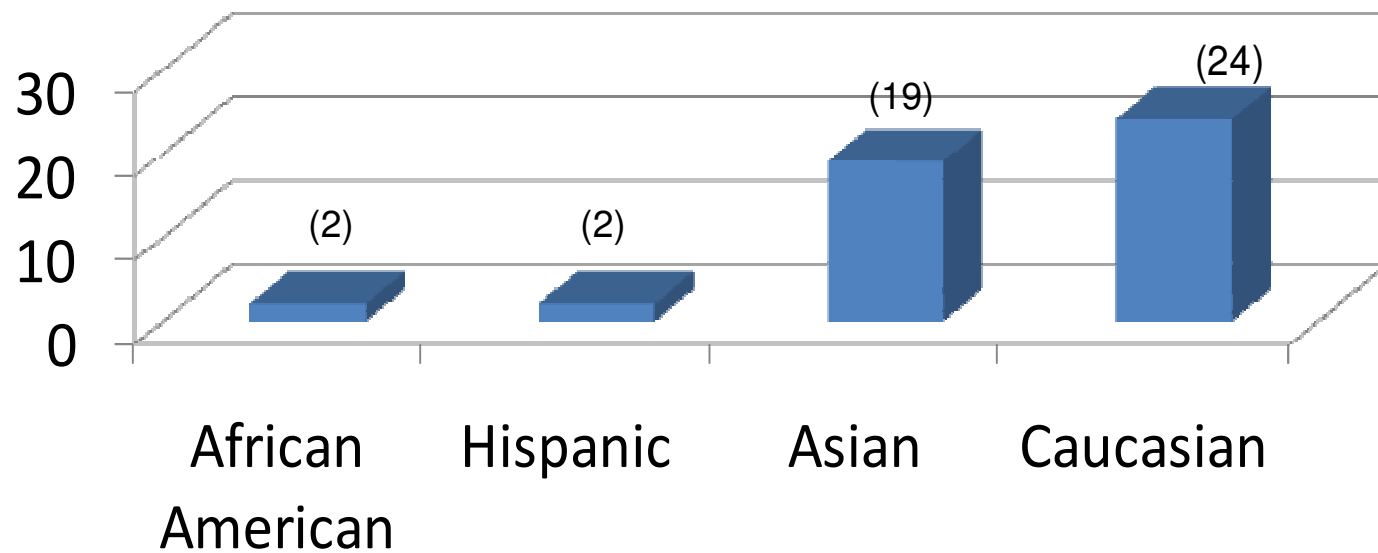


Grantee Specialty: 2003 – 2009

Grantee Ethnicity: 2003 – 2009

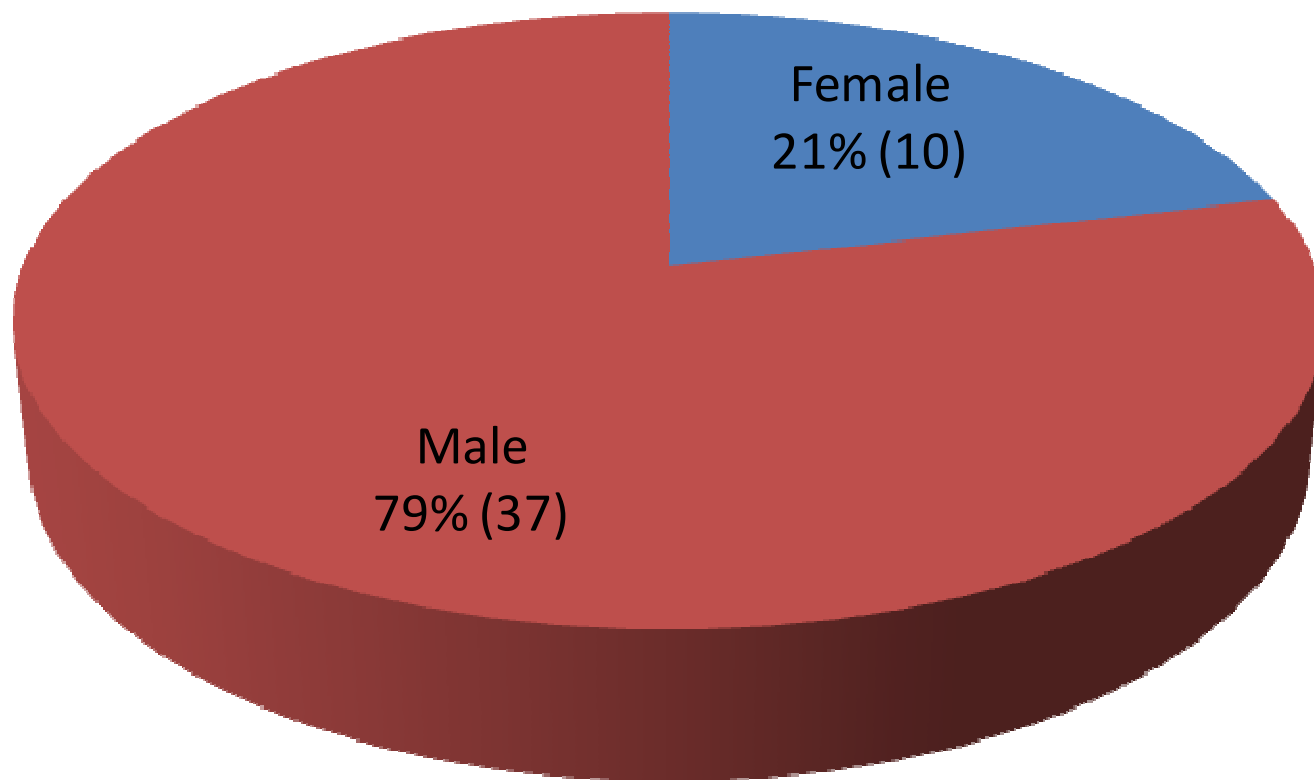


Note: "Asians" include Chinese, Japanese, Korean and Indian.
